For over 60 years the Garwood Foundation has supported people with disabilities in the Croydon area running a Day Centre and a Care Home for adults, a highly specialised school for pupils with profound and multiple learning disabilities aged from 3 to 25 years, and 3 charity shops. The charity provides activities and educational opportunities for children and adults with a wide range of abilities and medical conditions as well as supporting their families and carers. Despite the challenges of austerity in the care sector we are embarking upon an ambitious capital project to develop a vital new facility for profoundly disabled young adults.

The Foundation is now seeking a Finance Manager who will manage the charity's finances and work with our newly appointed Director of Services to face the future financial challenges and enable the Trustees to secure and develop the services for local people with disabilities.
